Thank you very, very much for the financial support for the excursion trip. I made a project for the tour. We were on an excursion to the Ogre region to the "Avārijas brigāde" park. (Total length of the excursion 540 km). I also organized a joint lunch during the excursion in the Bauska tower, we also visited the Bauska castle. We left on the excursion at 7 in the morning and were home only at 10 in the evening. However, despite the long, adventurous day, everyone was very excited about the excursion, everyone enjoyed everything very much.

A total of 28 people participated in the excursion (8 Sunday school students, 5 Ukrainians at a funeral together with 2 Ukrainian adults, one child raised by a half-sister (mother dead), one girl whose brother ran over on the side of the highway (dead), 6 of my grandchildren, 5 adults from my family and church (children shepherds  $\bigcirc$ ). On the day of the excursion, the weather was fantastic, we enjoyed a beautiful sunny day. As a surprise at the end of the day, there was a heavy downpour that happened about 20 min before the end of the planned excursion. For other children, this was one of their first outings in their lives - they had never been anywhere so far from their homes.

With the donated amount, we managed to cover most of the bus expenses, the total cost of the bus trip was 600 euros.

A few days back, we had an accident with our borehole water supply. The pipe was broken and the pump was only holding on to a 3mm metal joint. Fortunately, we managed to lift the pump with a crane, in order to get to the pump (the pump was installed in 1994), it was necessary to demolish the roof of the water pump house. The whole process took 2 days, as a result of which we were without water for two days, as well as unexpected additional expenses of 2,560 euros.

Once again, a very big thank you from me and all the participants of the tour, without your support we would not have managed such a beautiful tour!
